

Could I please put the following questions to the NW London CCG AGM on 28th October?

As the lead commissioners for the London Ambulance Service:

- 1) Has the CCG approved the LAS's 10 year plan to close 50% of their ambulance stations and create ambulance station hubs across London with the other 50% of ambulance stations?
- 2) What action is the CCG taking to eradicate ambulances and FRU's with diesel engines to comply with the objectives of COP 26?
- 3) In view of the failure of the LAS to achieve their C2, C3 and C4 targets, what action is the CCG taking to enable the LAS to meet the needs of patients desperately needing urgent and emergency care across London?
- 4) In view of the deteriorating C1 LAS performance (7 minute life threatened emergencies), what action will the CCG take to prevent deaths and harm to patients requiring a C1 response?
- 5) How many serious incidents have been declared in relation to deaths and harm caused by delay in reaching patients requiring an emergency LAS response?
