Hear Us

Hear Us is a Croydon-based mental health service user group which offers support and guidance to those who have mental illnesses.

In Croydon, the Service became involved in a unique project run by Hear Us which looked at trying to reduce the stigma surrounding mental illness.



Hear Us volunteers helped medics within the Service tackle mental illness in a patient care setting. Staff thoroughly enjoyed the workshops and found hearing real life stories and experiences extremely helpful.

Project Manager, Jane White's persistence and dedication has led Hear Us to be involved in many other areas of work within the Service.

The charity has been nominated for a Public Recognition award for their huge impact on the staff in Croydon and the Service as a whole, reducing the stigma of mental health.

Hear Us was nominated for this award by Vicki Hirst, Community Involvement Officer.

Paul Orange

In September last year, Paul was jogging on a tow path in Rickmansworth when he spotted a person floating face down in the river.

Paul immediately jumped in and pulled the person out. He subsequently called for help and stayed with the patient until help arrived.

The patient was severely ill and without Paul's intervention would almost certainly have died.

Paul was nominated for this award by Ian Wilmer, Advanced Paramedic Practitioner.
